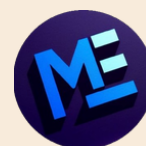

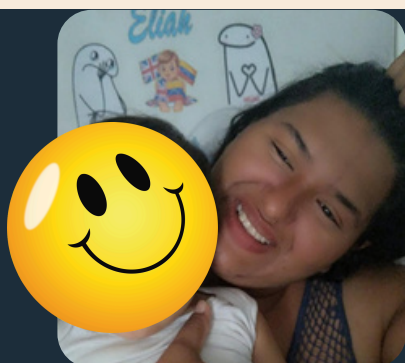
Robert & Bianca Emery

A few new things: he has finally had two teeth come through, 8.5 months after birth. He loves being in motion and is eager to walk, using the wall to help. He loves his food. If you don't share your food, or if you eat his, he gets visibly angry. He loves playing all the time and laughs a lot. He is very noisy.



We have just started an evangelism group. This is going well and enables us to reach out to the rest of the community here where we live. There are about 12 of us and our group visits about 2 people every two weeks, sharing the gospel of grace. This work is very tough but we are able to preach a very clear gospel message about repentance from sin and faith in Jesus Christ as the only cure to sin.



We are very happy to announce that the church, after many years, has finally started undergoing some repairs to the building. Thanks to the generous people who donated on GoFundMe. This was a very, VERY difficult process. I (Robert) had to prove my identity, and send all kinds of documents to them, as Venezuela is not a country they support. This was an absolute pain and took months to resolve. But finally, the money was sent over. They are currently repairing the wall outside, and many materials were bought for this, and different electrical cables were replaced for the lighting.

A few new things!

Something that needs to be mentioned, Bianca's mother has turned 60. We celebrated it with her and bought her a new set of gas hobs for her kitchen.

We have also finally about to move into our house! Hallelujah! After waiting 23 months! It has taken this long because we only had one worker, and he kept discovering the shoddy cheap work done by the lady who sold it to us. We have resolved them and are finally enjoying the fruit of our work.! I'll (Robert) never move again!
