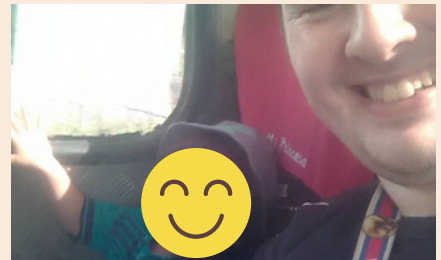
Many of us banded together and sent support to those in the affected areas. It was a sad time for Venezuela.

After that, though there are many small jobs to be done, this will be the last big job. Quite frankly, we are both fed up with how long this has taken. We believe the house will be completely finished in November. From then on, we will be saving money for a car and the family trip to the UK in 2029, which will be mentioned in just a moment.

Thanks to the generosity of those who gave through GoFundMe, we were able to renovate a lot of the church. We constructed the wall at the side of the church, we have added a shade in the church and made a way for us to be able to go the bathroom without problems from the rain. The work goes on, however, as we will be at some point, renovating the pulpit.



In 4 days (of this newsletter being sent), it will be Eliah's birthday. We are doing our best to organise a good time for him. We are also in the process of potty training him. Please pray for us! In October we will be applying for his British passport. It will last 5 years. For Eliah to be able to travel outside Venezuela he will need a Venezuelan passport. This was last for only 2 years, so we will need to apply for that a little later. I (Robert) am planning a big family trip to the UK (God willing) in the summer of 2029. We will introduce Eliah to many of you who are living in the UK.



My (Robert) visits are going well. We are visiting different houses every 2 or 3 weeks, preaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ. People here are far more receptive to spiritual things than people in Europe and are, in my experience, more open to the things of God. They have different struggles and problems but they are very happy to hear preaching.

When the rainy season finishes in November / December, we will be looking to organise more outdoor evangelistic events.
